The DITALS is an official certification released by the University for Foreigners of Siena. It aims to assess and verify the preparation (theoretical and practical) in teaching Italian as a second or a foreign language.

DITALS BASE is addressed to teachers of Italian FL whose native language is not Italian. Participants need almost a B2 level Certification in Italian as a Foreign Language but a specific University degree is not required.

The course aims to improve methodology and to increase language teaching skills as well as to prepare participants for the DITALS examination.

#### **Objectives**

- To provide participants with techniques and methodological approaches to teaching IFL
- To improve participants' awareness of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages
- To analyse language teaching resources and course material according to students' language level and needs
- To focus on the importance of grammar in communication
- To analyse exam past sample papers in order to prepare participants for the examination
- To provide opportunities to discuss about testing and evaluation
- To enhance participants' language skills

### COURSE CONTENT

Classes will focus on:

- An overview on Language Teaching Approaches
- Second Language Acquisition and the importance of input in IFL
- The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages
- How to evaluate course material and teaching resources

The role of grammar in communicative language teaching

- DITALS- Paper A: Analysis of teaching resources and course books
- DITALS- Paper B: Guided analysis of a text and teaching unit
- DITALS- Paper C: Glottodidactics
- Evaluation: How to evaluate and be evaluated reducing the affective filter

- A Certificate of Attendance and Achievement

### Course Content and Strategies

The course aims to improve methodology and to increase language teaching skills as well as to prepare participants to the DITALS BASE.

Lessons deal with the main techniques and methodological approaches to teaching Italian as FL/SL. Furthermore, participants will learn principles of planning for effective teaching and they will focus on selecting and planning the kinds of lessons that are most appropriate for particular learners.

DITALS BASE sample papers will be analysed in order to prepare participants for the examination. Some activities (Salerno city tour and cultural seminars) are included. Excursions and visits with tasting can be booked at extra cost.
